When presenting him with the award, the University of Washington cited Dr. Veith's work with Mobility Outreach International, as well as his work with a Mobility Outreach International partner, (the American Orthopedic Foot and Ankle Society (AOFAS), as part of the AOFAS Overseas Outreach Fellowship in Vietnam, as well as his involvement with the Natural Disaster Surgical Relief efforts in response to the devastating earthquake in Haiti. In addition to his medical practice and philanthropic clinical and surgical outreach missions, Dr. Veith also has an extensive history of presenting his research at local, regional, and national organizations, and of cultivating the next generation of orthopedic surgeons through lectures on clinical evaluation, treatment, and surgical techniques.
