FROM THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

Dear Friends:

I was thinking recently about my first encounter with Juan, a young man and bilateral lower limb amputee, in Ecuador in 1996. His mode of survival was daily begging at a public market, pushing himself around with his bare hands on a skateboard. When considering the lifetime of economic insecurity and stigma he would surely face, I couldn't help but feel troubled imagining how different my life would have been had I been born into his circumstances.

As a passionate advocate for social justice since then, I am dedicated to advancing the rights of marginalized and vulnerable people in the world's poorest nations. Working in the international nonprofit sector over the years has taught me the importance of focusing precious donor dollars on systemic change rather than short-term impact. Its focus on sustainability is one reason why I am so delighted to have joined Mobility Outreach International (MOi) as its new executive director this past May.

Since 1989, MOi has given physically disabled children and adults not only mobility and access to life-changing treatment, but "hope." MOi is dedicated to strengthening the capacity of health systems in low- and middle-income countries, providing prosthetic services, physical rehabilitation, orthopedic surgical outreach and treatment to children born with clubfoot. By offering training and facilitating the in-country production of prosthetics and orthotics, countries do not need to rely upon our services indefinitely, ensuring the long-term effectiveness of our innovative approach.

MOi's achievements in 2016 demonstrate our strong pattern of success. One of the most exciting outcomes was the growth of our Mobility Repair Centers (MRCs) which are strategically located to increase access to care for people who need prosthetic, orthotic, and wheelchair adjustments and repairs, without which use of their mobility device is often reduced or abandoned. Additionally, MOi invested in building local capacity of clinicians and prosthetists, provided technical assistance, treatment support and clinical training in Vietnam, Sierra Leone, and Haiti, orthopedic surgery in Vietnam, and technical support in Bangladesh. MOi is proud to have indirectly impacted more than 11,225 people across five countries last year, including approximately 4,862 direct beneficiaries.

While MOi has made extraordinary strides toward mobility for those we serve, there is still much more to do! We invite you to review our recent results, share the news of our success with others, and continue to passionately support our shared cause – giving people everywhere the access to mobility they deserve.






